

ORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
COMBINED RECREATIONAL FACILITY & WATER QUALITY DISTRICT

The Combined Recreational Facility & Water Quality District Board of Trustees is authorized and derives its organization from Iowa law. The Board will consist of seven board members. Board members are elected at large by property owners within the taxing district.

The board is organized for the purpose of setting policy and providing general direction for the taxing district. The board will hold its organizational meeting the first XXXX in August following the canvass of votes.

The current president shall preside over the election for the office of president. Upon completion of the election of president, the newly elected president will preside over the remainder of the meeting.

Policy protocol dictates:

The President will call for nominations for President of the Board of Directors. When nominations cease, the President will ask for a roll call vote in which each member of the board shall indicate for whom he or she is voting.

The candidate that garners the largest number of votes will be the President of the Combined Recreational Facility & Water Quality District for the 2012/2013 year.

At the completion of the election of the Board President, the newly elected president will preside for the remainder of the meeting. The President shall begin the process of the election of Secretary by calling for nominations and adhere to the officer election protocol as outline above. The same process will be followed for the election of Treasurer.
