## PRESIDENT

It is the responsibility of the Board President to lead a well-organized board in an efficient and effective manner. The Board President will set the tone of tone board meetings and, as the representative of the consensus of the board, speak on behalf of the board to the public.

The President of the Board is elected by a majority vote of the Board at the organizational meeting and will service a one-year term of office. Board members will make a motion to nominate candidate/s for the position of President. If only one candidate has been nominated for President, the motion to close nominations may also include a motion to case a unanimous ballot for the candidate. If more than one person is nominated, the President will ask for a roll-call vote for each nominee. The person receiving the most votes will be declared President.

The President, in addition to presiding at board meetings, will take an active role in board decisions by discussing and voting on each motion before the board in the same manner as the other board members.

The Board President has the authority to call special meetings of the Board. Prior to board meetings, the Board President may consult other board members on the development of the agenda for the meeting.
